In the recording, once the doctor inserts the plastic suction tube into the uterus, the baby appears to sense danger and can be seen recoiling away from the probing instrument. The power is turned on and the baby is quickly torn apart, leaving behind an empty womb. When the doctor viewed the ultrasound showing what had taken place, he became distraught and never performed another abortion.

Using this footage, Nathanson produced the short documentary on video called "The Silent Scream". It soon proved a powerful tool for exposing the reality of first-trimester abortion, so much so that pro-abortionists responded by accusing him of "doctoring" the film.

Nathanson countered with a written statement from the Scottish inventor of ultrasound that the film was a true and correct record.
