

## PROLIFE FACTS

The 2011 Voice for Life National Conference runs from 7:30 p.m. on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> November to 12:30 p.m. on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> November in Wellington. This is a particularly important Conference because, in 2012, it is anticipated that a coalition of pro-abortion activists will push for the decriminalisation of abortion in New Zealand. For the past two years, Victorian pro-abortion forces have been networking with their Kiwi counterparts, who include sympathetic and influential members of the NZ "medical establishment". Their model is the Abortion Law Reform Act, passed by the Victorian State Parliament in October 2008, which effectively decriminalised abortions and has resulted in a 600% increase in late-term abortions at the Royal Women's Hospital in Melbourne. Therefore, the theme of the VFL conference is "Be prepared: learn from Victoria". The keynote speaker will be Babette Francis from Melbourne, who played a leading role in the campaign against decriminalisation. Also speaking at the conference are Mike Sullivan (from Savingdowns), Roger Gilbride and Alisdair Hungerford-Morgan (ProlifeNZ), Catherine Bronnimann (SANDS) and Diane Belcher – a "mum on a mission".
